Punkte der Sekundarschule

1. General Updates:

- a. Lunch activities should continue, but at the moment, someone else is being sought who can continue this work.
- b. New tennis balls have arrived

2. Active & Clever:

- a. A refereeing course was proposed; teachers will review it, in Primary & Secondary.

3. Pickleball:

- a. Supported by the childminding afternoon activities
- b. Currently only one Eurosports sport.
- c. Could become a PE racket sport option in the future

4. Facilities:

- a. Plans for a new sports field (for cricket, rugby, and football) continue, though the Bad Vilbel town hall is currently against it.

5. Upcoming Events:

- a. Rugby Game: Nov 5 at FIS field, possibly with a junior team.
- b. Volleyball Tournament: Dec 19 after school, students vs. teachers.
- c. IB Netball Competition: Nov 14 (P3–P7), organised entirely by MYP 2–5 students.
- d. Sports Day: Apr 16, 8:40–15:16. All students attend; S7 can raise funds. Coordination with local police and the town is needed.
- e. Rugby is seasonal; basketball will take over next.
- f. Basketball Tournament in November (U16 and U18)
