



1. Secondary topics

1.1. Secondary clubs

There are many afternoon clubs already taking place. The enrolments are high. There will be more clubs starting in the 2nd semester. More boys than girls take part in the clubs so there will be more offers for female students.

Currently there is:

- Badminton, Tuesday, 16:10 to 17:10, Hanheiser S1 to S4
- Rugby, Tuesday, 16:10 to 17:10, Henn/Rodwell S3 to S7
- Volleyball, Thursday, 16:10 to 17:10, Rodwell S1 to S4
- Frisbee, Thursday, 16:10 to 17:10, Robinson S1 to S4
- Basketball, Thursday, 16:10 to 17:10, Henn S1 to S4
- Football, Friday, 13:00 to 14:00, Losada S1 to S4

The clubs aim to organize competitions with other schools.

In addition, Mr Rodwell organises games during the breaks. Football tournaments with students of different age groups take place at lunchtime.

Online registration (clubs) is required due to supervision obligations. If students are unable to attend, they must register their absence.

There will be a Rugby game in November hosted by FIS. It's a tournament with international schools, FIS is positive that also ESRM can take part.

The student reps informed that the FIS had enquired about a football tournament with two age groups. Mr. Losada will contact FIS to arrange ESRM participation. Maybe a similar connection for Rugby could be arranged. Mr. Rodwell will try to organize a place to host.

1.3. Eurosport 2026 Brussels IV

Eurosport is an event that takes place every two years. It unites all European and some accredited schools to compete in various sport disciplines in the spirit of fair competition, respect, friendship, equality, and joy.

In 2026 (Spring) Eurosport will take place in Brussels at Brussels IV in Laeken. In order to find interested and suitable students to take part in the Eurosport Competition, there will be an event in the Aula to present the event/tournament. After this there will be try outs to find participants for the afternoon club Eurosport next semester.

The tournament will take place in March 2026. Other schools take part with almost professional teams as Mr. Zijlstra mentioned. Semi-professional preparation is possible because the training sessions often take place during the school day. Unfortunately, this is not possible at ESRM.

The Eurosport competition is primarily reserved for the 14 original European Schools. In addition, there are 4 places for Accredited European Schools. It is a great privilege that the ESRM has been awarded such a place. The PE teachers are looking for a mixed team of 10 male and 10 female students for the following competitions:

- 3x3 Basketball for boys
- 5x5 ultimate frisbee for girls
- 2x2 pickle ball for mixed teams
- 6x6 touch rugby mixed teams
- Duathlon-Relay-race, this time a trail or obstacle run (so this time no swimming) mixed teams

Training for the tournament will be once a week, a training camp is planned. More information will follow.

Comment by Mr. Adams: There are P3-parents who own a pickle ball court nearby. Mr. Adams will arrange contact.

Side note: There is a dilemma with the age: There are no age specifications. But the older the students the better (physically advantageous) they are. But due to the upcoming BAC tests there is a "Gentlemen's Agreement" not to take S7-Students. No S7 - But 15 to 17 is possible. That means it is not realistic that S1-students will successfully compete with older ones.

2. Primary topics

2.1. Cricket

There is again Cricket offered by school. The offer is very well received. There is a participation fee of 100€ - 125€ per year for Primary students. 50 P3-P5 students and 30 S1-S5 students are enrolled.

The participation fee for Secondary students is 125€ per year. There are 30 students enrolled.

Mrs. Dunning trains in a separate session with the girls.

As in preparation for the German school championship in June in Cologne there is a training camp in Spain in February planned.

Money left is used to buy new equipment. A ball machine has already been purchased.

2.2. Netball

P3-P5 35 students very, very niche, most of them girls. Mr Adams tries to organize plays, tournaments, e.g. against St. Georg Cologne (Secondary too), Berlin

2 Teachers are qualified as European netball trainers. School is busy buying netball equipment.

2.3. Golf

New format – every training 12 Kids and 6 parents (“Eltern-Kind-Golf”), although it was the first time that somebody gets hurt the new format works very well.



2.4. Rugby

The school is invited by 1880 Frankfurt to take part in a tournament on November 20th in Frankfurt. Training for try outs already started. Training takes place 5 times during school. There are two age groups. Grundschule with P3 and P4 students and Weiterführende Schule with P5 and S1 students. Each age group will consist of 12. The older team will be joined by S1 students who already successfully took part in last year's tournament.

2.5. Swimming lessons

This year, swimming lessons take place in P2, P3 & P5. The swimming teachers travel to the indoor pool in Karben with P3 and P5 class. The 44 children are supervised by 2 teachers. This arrangement works very well. The swimming times are optimised as a result. Thank you to Mr Mansson for arranging this possibility.
